EU: European pharmaceutical industry groups jointly publish new "E-PI Position Paper"

On January 8, 2025, European pharmaceutical industry associations (AESGP, EFPIA, Medicines for Europe) jointly published a new version of the E-PI Promotion Position Paper proposed for European regulatory authorities.

The proposal outlines a strategic shift from the current paper leaflets to more patient—centric content and accessible, environmentally friendly digital alternatives, which are proposed to optimise pharmacy operations while keeping patient safety at the forefront.
