US: USTR published 2024 Special 301 Report

On 25 April, the Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) published the 2024 Special 301 Report on intellectual property protection.

US: DEA announced the classification of marijuana is to be changed from

Schedule 1 to 3

On 16 May, the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) announced that they will revise the Controlled Substances Act (CSA) and cannabis will be changed from Schedule 1 to Schedule 3, the same as Tylenol with codeine and steroids. The final decision will be made after going through a process of accepting objections, etc.

On 14 May, the Association of the European Self-Care Industry (AESGP) held Webinar "From Paper to Digital Leaflet: Making Patient Information More Inclusive".

In 2023, AESGP commissioned Ipsos European Public Affairs to run a consumer survey in six EU Member States as a first step towards building a better understanding of EU consumers' perceptions and expectations with regard to product information for non-prescription medicines and their readiness to use digital formats.

This event introduced the main findings of the survey and discuss how best to implement the transition from paper to digital leaflets.
